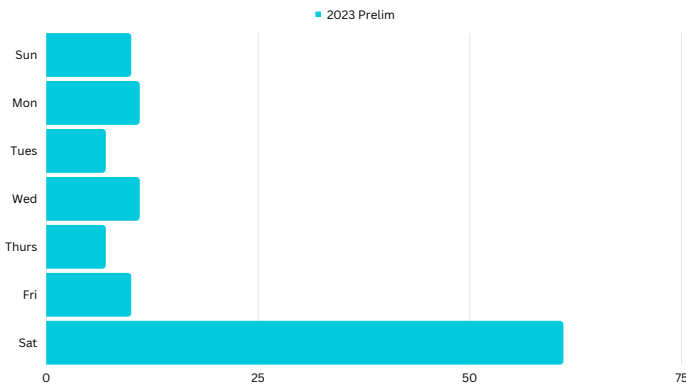

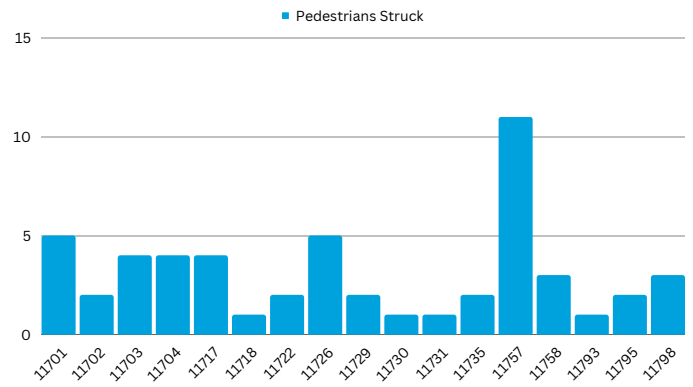

Incidence of 2023 Pedestrian Strikes by Day of the Week



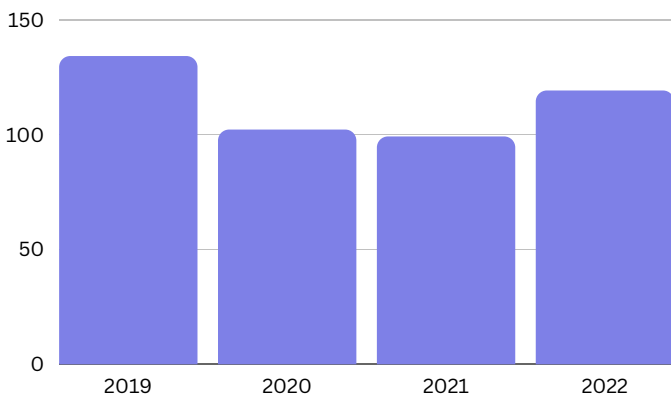
Location of 2023 Pedestrian Strikes by Zip Code



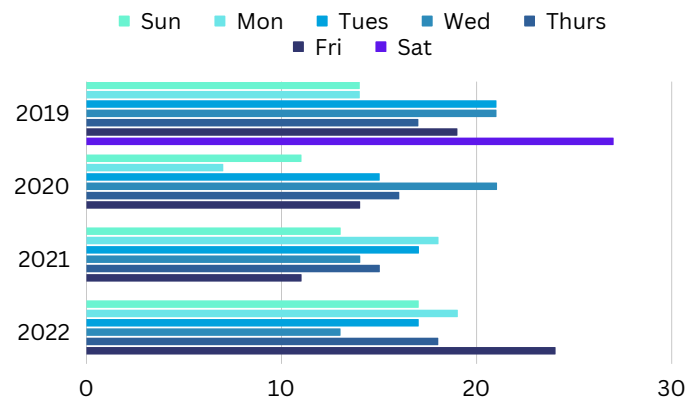
